President's Report - Liz Luyendyk

- Organizational overview
 - o PTO is the fundraising arm of Cornell. Everything we raise, we give back to the school.
 - Cougar Run usually raises around \$19K
 - PTO's biggest expense is giving teachers gift cards at the beginning of the year (\$300/classroom teacher)

Treasurer's Report - Corinne Dyksen

- Financial standing end of 2021/2022 school year and beginning 2022/2023
- Transparency is a top priority if you ever have questions, please email treasurer@cornellpto.org
- Looking to form financial oversight committee
 - This committee will look at statements twice a year to approve for insurance purposes
 - Chris Silker volunteered his wife, Kelly Silker, who has a masters in accounting
- Our old bank (Citizens) closed and the closest one was Owosso, so we switched to MSUFCU
 - o became a select employee group www.msufcu.org/segs
- Income:
 - o carried over \$18,242.87 from last year
 - o earned \$565.66 from Amazon Smile (\$83.03) and yearbook sales (\$482.29)
- Expenses:
 - o \$10,312.33 spent
 - o largest portions were staff start up (\$8106.04), sick bench (\$745), and last year's yearbook (spent \$671.76 but actual cost is \$190 after sales)
- Upcoming expenses:
 - o portable PA sound system
 - Augie Martinez might might be able to help with this
- Grant request from music teacher
 - Ms. Chase applied for an OEF grant for a set of ukuleles for music room
- Cougar of the Week working with SSA to bring this back and make it more inclusive.
 Maybe one student from every classroom on a more regular basis. PTO will fund this.
